

Where Should I Go?

“I want to see animals”

Follow the paved and gravel “Farm Path” through the children’s garden and up to the Farmyard. While our animals move into various pastures, you can expect to see our farm animals along that path and inside the Alfalfa Barn and Hen House.

“I want to hike”

Enter our hiking trails at any of our trail entrances (most easily accessible from the parking lot is Jimmy’s Trail). Wander up to the Overlook to see the city and don’t forget to stop by the Bird Blind to relax.

“I want to see food growing”

Enjoy the small garden beds next to our Children’s Garden and make your way on the “Farm Path” past the Market Garden to see where much of our food production happens. Wander up to the crop fields to see what we’re growing for animal feed!

“I want to relax in nature”

Grab a seat in the Trosset Wildflower Sanctuary adjacent to the pavilion to see the native plants and listen to the birds. Take a wander through the gardens to enjoy the blooms too!

“I want to play with my kid”

Explore in the Children’s Garden where you can use your five senses, play games, and see our education chickens and rabbits.
